The 4th annual Explorer Recognition Dinner will be held on March 19th at the Clovis Veterans memorial Building. Dinner begins at 6:00 PM followed by a guest speaker and recognition of the youth and advisors that have participated in the Exploring program.

There are 227 United States Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (MCJROTC) Programs. Our ten western states, Hawaii, Alaska and the Department of Defense Schools in the Far East are under the authority of the 12th Marine Corps District (MCD). Because of its location in the State of California, the Selma High School MCJROTC Program is part of the 12th MCD.

Each year all JROTC programs compete for the distinguished designation of National Honor School (NHS). That special recognition places a program within the top twenty percent of all high school JROTC programs. For the past eleven years Selma High School has never placed below the top five percent, earning it the NHS designation for each of those years and once again for the twelfth time just this past school year.

The single most noteworthy school is selected for special recognition by the Marine Corps Retired Officers Association (MCROA). The most accomplished school receives the MCROA Outstanding Unit Award - the Commandant of the Marine Corps Trophy. After many second and third place finishes over the past eleven years, the Selma High School United States Marine Corps JROTC Program has been selected as the top school and honored with the MCROA Outstanding Unit Award.
