



2010 National Scout Jamboree Fact Sheet

Dates: July 26 through August 4, 2010 at Fort A.P. Hill, Virginia.

Travel Plans: The Sequoia Council Jamboree Contingent will leave Fresno on July 20th arriving in Philadelphia, PA late in the evening of July 20th. The contingent will travel to a variety of historical sites in Pennsylvania, Maryland and Washington D.C. While in Washington, D.C. ample time will be allowed to tour the Smithsonian Institution, the White House, and many more federal offices, such as the FBI and the Capitol. The contingent will arrive at the National Scout Jamboree site on July 26th and remain there until the morning of August 4th. One additional day will be spent in Virginia for rest, relaxation and fun before returning to Fresno on August 5th.

Organization: The Jamboree is open to all Scouts who are qualified on a first-come basis:

- are at least First Class rank
- graduated from 6th grade or be 12 years old by July 1, 2010 and not reached his 18th birthday before August 3, 2010
- be active in his unit for at least 6 months prior to July 1, 2010
- complete the medical form
- approved by unit leader
- approved by Council Jamboree Committee

We have two troops scheduled to attend the National Scout Jamboree. Our troops are composed of Scouts from all over the Sequoia Council. Each troop has four adult leaders along with 28 Scouts. Our troops will be joined at the Jamboree site by two patrols of International Scouts along with their adult leaders.

Total Cost: The cost per Scout is set at \$3,400. The Jamboree fee covers all transportation, tours, admission fees, meals, lodging and patrol and troop equipment as well as insurance. The fees also cover pre-jamboree training campouts. The only additional expense to the Scout will be for his individual uniforms, personal equipment and spending money.

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
