- Insect repellent, sunscreen, closed toed shoes & hat
- Medication & Annual Health and Medical Record parts A & B
- Folding chair for you and your Akela
- A water bottle/canteen
- Mess kits
- Fire wood (you can collect dead and down but it is scarce) Fire pits are available
- Pocket knife is allowed with whittling n chip card. Misuse will have pocket knife confiscated and returned to adult leader
