

Dear Scout Volunteer,

Thank you for your commitment to the youth in your community and for making the world a better place. Scouting is the best program to help youth grow and develop character, values, and leadership.

There are 5 steps to becoming a registered leader.

- Complete the <u>Adult Application Form</u>. Please look at the form carefully and be sure to include your initial in two spots, answer the questions on #6, and sign the last page. All adult applications **MUST** be signed by your unit's Charter Organization Representative before submitting.
- 2. Complete Youth Protection Training (YPT). You will need to create an account at My.Scouting.org and take the 90 minute course. When you create an account and log in click on the grey/black box on the right side of your screen.



3. The State of California requires that all adults who work or volunteer with youth in any organization complete a Mandated Youth Reporter training. This is a 2 hour course. A link to the full explanation and the class itself can be found here: https://californiascouting.org When you finish you will need to upload your certificate to https://californiascouting.org/sequoia/ You may also attach it to your adult application for submittal.



- 4. Sign the attached Background Check Consent Form and return it with your application or upload to https://californiascouting.org/sequoia/ with proof of Mandated Reporter Training.
- 5. Get fingerprinted. You will need to take the attached form to a Live Scan certified office and get fingerprinted. This is now a digital process now. The form already has our council's code on it so results will come to us. A list of locations where you can complete the fingerprinting can be found at https://oag.ca.gov/fingerprints/locations
